- 12.2 A senior Officer representing each of the Parties shall meet within 14 days of receipt of a notice to attempt to resolve the dispute.
- 12.3 Should the action in Clause 12.2 fail to resolve the district, the Chin Executives of the Parties shall meet within 14 days of the meeting have to inclause 12.2 and attempt to resolve the dispute.

- 16.2 A waiver of a breach of any of the terms of this Agreement or of a default under this Agreement does not constitute a waiver of any other breach or default and shall not affect the other terms of this Agreement.
- 16.3 A waiver of a breach of any of the terms of this Agreement or a default under this Agreement will not prevent a Party from subsequently require compliance with the waived obligation.

17 NOTICE

- 17.1 Any notice given to a Party under or in connection with the greement should be in writing and shall be:

- 18.1 Nothing contained or implied herein shall prejudice or affect the Parties' rights and powers duties and obligations in the exercise of their functions as Local Authorities and/or in any other capacity and all rights powers discretions duties and obligations of the Parties under all Laws may at all times be fully and effectually exercised as if the Parties were not party to this Agreement and as if this Agreement had not been made.
- 18.2 The Parties shall only represent themselves as being an agent, partner or employee of any other Party to the extent specified by this Agreement and shall not hold

themselves out as such nor as having any power or authority to incur any obligation of any nature express or implied on behalf of any other Party except to the extent specified in this Agreement.

- 18.3 This Agreement is personal to the Parties and no Party shall assign transfer or purport to assign or transfer to any other persons any of its rights or sub-contract any of its obligations under this Agreement.
- 18.4 No person other than the Parties shall be entitled to enforce any of its terms under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999.
- 18.5 The Parties shall at all times deal with one another and the espective rights and responsibilities under this Agreement in good faith including respect of any disputes between them.
- 18.6 If any term, condition or provision of this Agreement will be add to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable to any extent, such term, conditioned provision shall not affect the validity, legality and enforceability of the other provisions of or any other documents referred to in this Agreement.
- 18.7 The Parties commit to share data and knowledge relevant to the Frameworks where appropriate and in accordance with the part of the Data of tection Act 2018.
- 18.8 This Agreement may be exected in any number of counterparts and by the Parties on separate counterparts but shownot be dective until each Party has executed at least one counterpart. Even counterparts onen executed, shall be an original of this Agreement and all counterparts shall mether constitute one instrument.
